RULES

On behalf of the Nebraska Loading Rifle Association and this year's Booshway we would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to the Red White and Blue Rendezvous. In order to assure that all of our members and guests have a fun safe weekend we ask that you take a moment to familiarize yourselves with some of our rules and guidelines.

1. Vehicles must be parked in designated areas only. Please unload in a timely manner and move your vehicle to a parking area.
2. The firing of any firearm in camp or in any area other than the firing range during designated hours is strictly forbidden.
3. There are to be no fireworks lit on Club property.
4. All pets must be on a leash and under the owners control at all times.
5. The tin cup rule is in effect at all times. All beverages must be in approved containers - no plastic bottles or aluminum cans.
6. Please be respectful and pick up all litter. Pack out all trash.
7. Each camp will have a fire bucket full of water.
8. Parents and adults are and will be held accountable for the actions of their children or any minors in their camp.
